Donna Ana County

The origin ^{of the name for} of Donna Ana County, is unclear. One version gives credit for a ~~city~~ woman named Donna Ana Cordoba who was reputed to have lived in the area in the early 1600s. Most historians agree ~~the name~~ ^{the name} originates from Donna Ana Robledo, an elderly woman who was a member of the refugees fleeing south during the 1680 Pueblo Revolt. She succumbed on the trail and was buried below the peak near the present day village and below the peak that bears her surname in memory of the death of her grandfather who died and was buried there in 1598.
